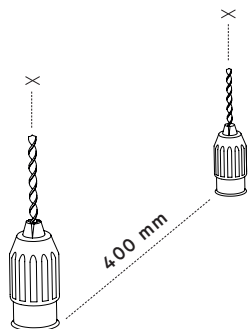
- 1 Use the screwdriver to tighten the adjuster halfway into the plates.



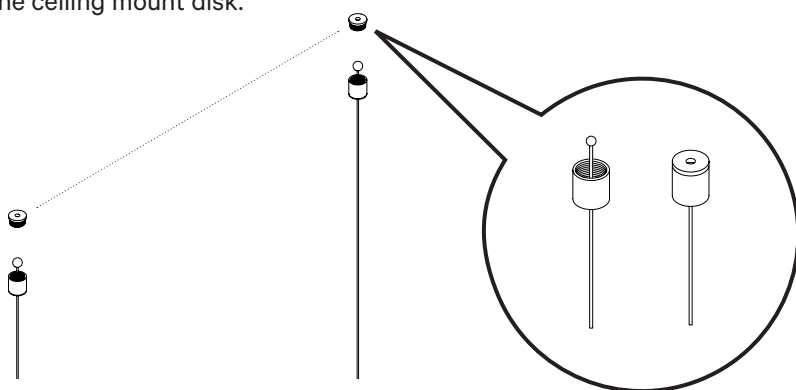
- 2 Now tighten the screws on the panel on both sides.



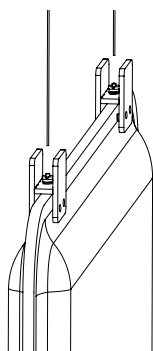
- 3 Drill holes with 400 mm between them. Insert wall plugs and screw the ceiling mount disk into the ceiling plug.



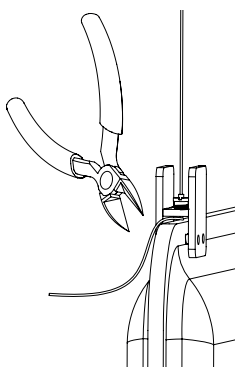
- 4 Insert the steel cable into the ceiling cap. Then mount the ceiling cap on the ceiling mount disk.



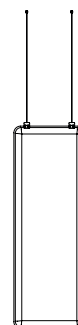
- 5 Push the 2 steel cables into the cable adjusters.



- 6 Cut off the excess cable.



- 7 The assembly of the AK 3/4 Vertical Hanging Fixture is now completed.
